Grant of Leave Travel Concession (LTC) to the member of West Bengal Judicial Service as per recommendations of the Shetty Commission.

I am directed to invite a reference to above and to say that in supersession of all previous orders issued in this respect the Governor has been pleased to sanction with retrospective effect from 1st April, 2007 Leave Travel Concession to all members of West Bengal Judicial Service once in four years to any place in India. For entitlement of first LTC one must have put in not less than 5 years of continuous service. No LTC shall be allowed within one year before retirement.

Provided further that there shall not be any carry forward of LTC beyond retirement and that the rate of such concession will be admissible as per prevailing LTC Rules of the Central Government.

The charge is debitable from the sub-detailed head "07-other Allowances" subordinate to the Detailed Head "01-Salaries" under the respective salary heads of the concerned Judicial Officers.
