The annual calendars of SJAs be prepared in a manner that to the extent practicable, the distribution of subjects be divided in the ratio of 80:20 between pan India subjects and state specific subjects (the proportion shall be 50:50 for the States of Nagaland, Mizoram, Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh and Manipur).
